I don't know about you, but Lent/Holy Week and Easter felt different this year, in a good way. I was speaking today with a pastoral friend, and we both said that it felt like we emerged – finally – on the other side of the last several years of COVID-weirdness. But the services didn't go back to anything – it just felt new.

It was the connection I experienced with so many of you as we walked through Lent and the fantastic devotional thoughts you were willing to share as part of our publication. It was the power of being with other churches in the community each Thursday for a simple lunch of soup and scripture. It was wrapping up a study that both our staff and our council had been working through on the "one anothers" we find in scripture. It was seeing so many helpers and so many kids' families enjoy the story and the fun at Easter Jam. It was the power of sharing around tables on Maundy Thursday and seeing the sanctuary as it grew darker as the story of Christ's passion was read by all of us. It was coming together, starting before the sun rose, to celebrate the truth that Jesus is alive, and the promise of resurrection that is ours because of that.

That's when it struck me. We're experiencing resurrection together. There has been death and loss that many of us have experienced over the last several years. As a church, we have experienced the loss of faithful saints who have run their race and now rest from their labor. We have walked with families through painful transitions, as marriages ended, or relationships have been broken. We have said goodbye to old ways of doing things, and realized that some practices, some people, some of us aren't coming back again.

But though Jesus looked different in the garden following his resurrection – as Mary thought he was the hired hand – he was still alive nonetheless. And we, all of us, and we as the church, are different because of the last several years. But we're alive. And Jesus is showing up all over the place. As we continue to study God's Word together. As we continue to serve our neighbors together. As we have joyful conversations and hard conversations together. As we step out into a brand new day of ministry together.

So I just wanted to say thank you. Thank you for taking this journey with me. Thank you for the privilege I have of being your pastor – in all of it. Thank you for seeking after Jesus, and for trying to live like Jesus, day by day. I love being your pastor, and I thank God every day for the gift of life as we continue to become new. In Christ.



One half will go to our global partner UMCOR (United Methodist Committee on Relief) which is on the ground and providing relief with folks responding to the devastation left by the earthquakes in Turkey and Syria.

The other \$11, 722.00 will go to Sojourner Truth Ministries in Williamsport which provides meals, support, and belonging for folks experiencing homelessness, joblessness, or other distress right here in our back yard. Our offering will support their ongoing work and provide necessities for those who cannot afford them.

A special thank you to those who gave generously to love and care for our neighbors both at home and abroad.
