THE VIEW FROM HERE

God's Spirit is on the move here at Faith Church. I don't say that lightly, but I believe with all of my heart that what we're seeing here is nothing less than a movement of God in our midst. I see it in a hundred different ways, but here are some of them.

- I hear us engaging in worship more fully, singing with more passion in worship, whether a traditional hymn or the newest praise song, and connecting with God's Word however it's coming to us. Particularly, when we're invited to respond in specific ways to what we're hearing.
- I see growing community, evidenced in times of fellowship after worship, times of learning in community groups, and in relationships that are being built.
- I get to read the connect cards each week, joining you in the prayers you're lifting up, and celebrating the next steps that you are marking in your own faith journey.
- · I experience it in the growing heart of service and generosity that God is building in us all. In times of challenging transition, you have stepped up to say, "Whatever the church needs, I'm here." Our financial generosity is making some important steps, too, as we continue to discern God's next faithful steps.
- I get to feel it as we gather as a staff to pray, to learn and to work together. A spirit of connection, commitment and joy pervade even as we work through challenges and seek to clarify God's direction while doing the 'normal stuff' that keeps a church moving.

All of this continues to draw me in prayer to something I've encouraged us all to pray regularly:

Lord, I'm yours. We are yours. This church is yours. The Church and the whole world are yours. Amen.

As we continue to walk in this wave of God's goodness together, I encourage you to keep on praying that prayer. Keep on spending time in God's Word to grow deeper in love with the God who reveals himself there. Keep on saying yes to the nudges of the Spirit that you feel — whether it's reaching out to a friend, stepping out in leading a ministry, responding in worship by raising your hands and singing in full voice, or any of the million ways God's Spirit nudges. And trust God with the outcome. I know I am!




HOSPITALITY FOR ANNUAL CONFERENCE


