

CHURCH COUNCIL NOMINATIONS

Our Church Council, made up of 9 members elected for up to two consecutive three-year terms exists to ensure the vision of helping people connect in worship, grow in community groups, serve the body of Christ and go into the world to make disciples of Jesus. The Church Council at Faith Church focuses their work in three areas (Staffing, Facilities and Finance) including:

- Approve the Annual Budget.
- Approve the hiring of any member of the Leadership Team.
- Annually review the Lead Pastor in conjunction with the District Superintendent.
- Approve all land acquisitions, facility construction and significant legal obligations.

• When a special need exists, the Council can create a task force consisting of a sub-group of the board and/or other church members. This would include the election of new members to the Church Council.

• Actively pursue learning opportunities as it relates to large church structure and development. This could include books, conferences and other learning tools.

Folks that serve on the Church Council should possess the following character traits:

- Compassion (love for Jesus, his people, and his mission).
- Competency (skills consistent with human resources, operations and stewardship).
- Creativity (ability to look at the total of God's resources and bring the best into the church).
