PASTOR'S PEN

I recently had the chance to hear a little of the faith story from a young woman in our congregation that reminded me of what the mission of the church looks like. She is a young mom of four kids. A few years ago, she and her husband, walked into the door of Faith Church and reconnected with the church and with Jesus.

She began worshipping regularly, joined our open community group, Merge, took one of our Foundations classes, began to read the Bible regularly as a way to listen for God's voice in her life, and has found multiple places to serve with her gifts. As she talked you could hear how she had been walking our discipleship pathway – Connect, Grow, Serve, and Go.

In our conversation, she shared the ways that Jesus had been changing her. She is more peaceful, she is less anxious, and she has learned how to reach out and share Jesus' love with others who she would have previously avoided. She talked about how she had come to see sharing the love of Jesus with her kids and the people she met as the most important thing in her life. As she talked you could see the joy in her face. **"I just want to share the love of Jesus with others the way that it was**

shared with me here at Faith Church," she said.

Sometimes, a mission statement can just become words on a page. Many of you know that the mission of Faith Church is to "Make disciples of Jesus Christ, who connect, grow, serve, and go, for the transformation of the world". As I listened to Jess share her story, I was reminded that our mission is best seen in the lives of people whose lives are being changed as they become disciples of Jesus. Jesus is changing her from the inside out through the mission and people of Faith Church.

It is incredible to know that you are part of changing someone else's life. God allows us the great privilege to be partners with God in that work. Praise God, and may we continue to lean forward together to see many more stories like Jess's. May our mission always be more than some words we put on a wall or in our bulletin. May our mission be constantly embodied in us and the people God calls us to reach. Amen

The General Conference meeting in 2019 will focus on how to help the denomination move forward faithfully amid disagreements within the United Methodist Church about the inclusion of LGBTQ folks in the life of the denomination.

Hello Faith Church,

One of the yearly things that I enjoy most as a part of serving on Church Council is the opportunity to attending Annual Conference. As members of The Susquehanna Annual Conference, we are asked to elect two voting delegates to attend Annual Conference each year where the Conference gathers to participate in a blend of work and worship, both covered in prayer. We at Faith Church were so very lucky to have Bishop Park speak in May at our Children's Wing Consecration and you can imagine he runs and organizes a very entertaining Annual Conference. You simply never know when he's going to shout Hallelujah, followed by a hymn number to the pianist.

This theme for the 2016-2020 Quadrennium is Better Together and this year's focus is One with Christ. The other Faith Church delegate, Ryan Tira and myself enjoyed the Laity Session which always kicks off the Annual Conference for the Laity. The Director of Equipping Vital Congregations, Kay Kotan, gave one of several talks for the three day conference, titled "We are (not just) lay people, We are lay people!" She spoke on Nehemiah, calling him a perfect role model for lay people. He possessed many qualities that we all strive for, but notably he had never been a leader before, had no training, and was actually a servant far from his homeland. She went on to outline eight areas for us to seek to make an impact.

Over the next couple days, we worshiped, learned, walked through the business agenda our Susquehanna Conference, and spent many separate times in prayer. Bishop Park was very intentional about this, just as he was last year. Prayer needs to be the foundation for our decisions and discernment for our church, our conference, our denomination, and our world.

We also had a small group time to discuss the Council of Bishops recommendation on a Way Forward. We were randomly broken up in to groups of seven or eight to discuss several questions. It was a mix of pastors and laity. I left the time feeling encouraged that our Church and our Church Council had already begun talking and providing space for such discussions.

I would very much encourage you to check out the conference website, and more specifically the Daily Link. It's found at <http://www.susumc.org/index.php/about-us/annual-conference-archive/annual-conference-2018> under Printed Materials. It's a daily newspaper, with 4 editions, detailing the Annual Conference. If you take the time to read it, you'll likely find some plagiarism on my part, but it's worth taking the time to review. KID CONNECTION - ORANGE SPOTLIGHT (THE YELLOW OF CHURCH AND THE RED OF HOME COMBINE TO MAKE ORANGE.)
 During August, we will encourage our kids to look to God and His Word to know what is wise and good. Our preschoolers learn that God's way is perfect and He can help us know the right way to go. They will see that God's way is not always easy, but it is always good. They will look at Jonah, Namaan, Josiah, and Gideon and see that it can be hard to follow God, but in the end it is always for the best. Meanwhile, our elementary kids are on a hunt for wisdom which the Bible tells us is a great treasure. Wisdom is finding out what you should do and doing it! Sometimes the right choice is obvious, but other times we find ourselves facing two or more options that all seem like good choices. Our kids need to grow in wisdom as they grow in stature, just like we're told Jesus did as a boy in the book of Luke. Our goal is that our kids will learn to see the difference between right and wrong, but also develop wisdom and discernment to follow God's leading when faced with choices that are truly complicated. Our lessons will instruct them to look to God, pray, and discuss with trusted friends who are wise in order to grow in wisdom and live in ways that show they have confidence in God.
