

February Sermon Series: Defying Gravity!



<u>Next Steps in Fulfilling Our Vision – Church Conference</u> **Vote**

Mark your calendars for another historic day at Faith UMC. At 11am on Sunday March 19, we will hold a Church Conference vote on the recommendation of our Facilities Design Team and Church Council for Phase 1 of our building addition. The vote will allow us to move forward with groundbreaking in summer 2017 of Phase 1 of the Faith Church vision of a new children's ministry space and a multipurpose worship center and gym embraced in 2014 during the Journey Campaign. You will receive more information in the coming weeks about the full recommendation. We will be voting on the design plans and the first phase of construction including financing. All members of the congregation are able to vote on the recommendation, and anyone may attend. Our District Superintendent Rev. Beth Jones will be with us to lead the church conference vote and to celebrate with us the next step in our journey to touch more lives, make more disciples, and raise up a new generation of Jesus-followers.


AMAZON SMILE – and Faith Church!

Safe Sanctuaries

Coming up in March, we will be offering two trainings for Safe Sanctuaries. Sunday, March 12 at 11:15 am & Saturday, March 18 at 10:00 am. Ministry Leader Opportunity

Faith Church currently partners with the Central Pennsylvania Food Bank by packing senior citizen food boxes the first Tuesday of each month. The Food Bank has a new program called "Fresh Express" where time sensitive food products (milk, eggs, produce, etc.) are distributed on a monthly basis throughout our geographic region. Montoursville is one of the Food Bank's target distribution areas. We have had an initial meeting with representatives from the Food Bank and believe we could be a Fresh Express distribution site on the second Thursday of each month. However, this can only happen if we have a servant or two who are willing to lead this ministry and work through the process of organizing and setting it up.
