

It is that time of year when we put up the new calendar and try to remember to write '18 on all of our checks. It is a time to reflect on the events of the past year, make New Year resolutions and wonder about what God may have in store for us in the next twelve months. I'd like to pause with you a moment to reflect on last year and dream of the year to come.

In the last year at Faith we have seen God at work in some amazing ways among us. At our Church Conference on December 10, we celebrated **God's work in making new disciples**. We welcomed twenty-seven new members this year and that twenty of those were received by profession or reaffirmation of faith. In addition, we celebrated thirteen new births in the congregation and had eleven baptisms. These are more than numbers. They represent people who are being touched by the love of God as they become disciples of Jesus. In addition, we affirmed the calling of Greg Moyer to pursue a calling into pastoral ministry.

In May we celebrated **groundbreaking for our new building**, a dream and prayer of the congregation for almost 30 years. As we watched foundations being laid, we knew that the additional space will lay the foundation for the next 40 years of ministry. We dreamed and prayed that it would help us to make sure that no child in our community grows up without

experiences the love of Jesus, no person in our community will go to bed hungry, and no person in our community will miss the invitation to follow Jesus.

In December we celebrated the results of our **JOURNEY: Next Steps Capital Campaign**. Together we gave and committed an amazing \$1.2 million dollars. These gifts will allow us to grow into the financing of our loan for Phase 1 of construction AND help us complete a significant portion of the remaining master plan. The Finance Team, Church Council, and Facilities Design Team will now work with those pledges to determine how far and how fast we can move towards our master building plan. We feel confident that these pledges will enable us to complete enough of the multipurpose gym to begin using it in the next few years.

In addition we continued to GO serve our neighbors in need here and around the world. We packed 100,000 meals at our November food-packing event, sent over 30 people on mission trips, and served people in our community who are homeless, hungry, and in need through dozens of ministry partners.

God is doing amazing things at Faith Church and will continue in **2018**. We are praying that our children's wing may be open around Easter and by the fall our new food distribution site should be operating and sharing food with our neighbors. These new steps of faith will stretch us into a new season of even greater impact in our community and even more people experiencing the joy of following Jesus. We have much to be thankful for from 2017, and much to anticipate in 2018. What an awesome time to be the church! God is good, all the time. All the time, God is good.
