We are in a season at Faith Church in which God is doing a new thing. Consider all that is happening in March. This month we are moving through transitions in our staff leadership, opening our new Children's Wing, beginning renovations in the old Children's Wing that will allow us to open a Food

Bank and finish staff offices, and holding a Church Conference to approve moving ahead with parts of our Phase 2 construction. We do all of this while preparing to celebrate Easter as we remember our story and God's story together in worship. As God does new things among us, like the disciples it may take us a while to get our bearings, but I am confident that God is up to something incredible and is preparing us for a fresh movement of God that will exceed all of our expectations.

CHILDREN'S WING OPENING!!!

Construction in the new Children's Wing is nearing completion and we are expecting to gain occupancy in the first week of March. We have set the move dates for the Preschool and our weekend Kids Connection. The first day of Preschool classes in the new wing will be Wednesday March 14. Move-in weekend for Kids Connection will be March 17/18. See the Children's page for more details about how you can help us with the move and Open House days for families to check out the new space. We also just confirmed that our Bishop, Jeremiah Park will be with us in May to preach and to consecrate the new wing!

SPECIAL CHURCH CONFERENCE TO APPROVE PLAN FOR PHASE 2 CONSTRUCTION

We will have a Church Conference on Monday, March 19 at 7:00 pm in the Sanctuary to approve the beginning of some pieces of phase 2 construction. Because of your generosity in the JOURNEY: Next Steps campaign we will have the ability to begin parts of the work on our multipurpose gym in 2018. The Church Council has proposed a plan that would allow us to move forward this year with the funds available. Come out to informational sessions after worship on Saturday, March 10 at 6:45 pm and Sunday, March 11 at 11:00 am. There you can ask questions and get updates on the progress towards our vision!

STAFF LEADERSHIP TRANSITIONS

At the end of February and beginning of March we celebrated the ministry of Rusty Wolfinger as Associate Pastor and Tony Sharp as Worship Director as they move to new seasons of ministry (Pastor Rusty to Las Vegas and Tony Sharp to Tennessee). Joe Tokay will be stepping in as Interim Worship Leader beginning Sunday, March 11 and will lead us through the worship leader transition. We are working with our District Superintendent, Beth Jones, and Bishop Jeremiah Park on the appointment of our next Associate Pastor. Stay tuned for more updates and keep praying that we will see clearly the people God is calling to lead Faith Church in the next season of ministry.

HOLY WEEK WORSHIP

Plan now to experience the full story and the full power of Easter by participating in our Holy Week services. Thursday, March 29 at 7:00 pm will be our Maundy Thursday service. We will share in Communion as we remember the last meal Jesus had with His disciples and His last words to them. ORANGE SPOTLIGHT

During March, our Kid Connection attenders will continue to explore the wonder of who God is and all that He has done for us. Preschoolers will remember that Jesus wants to be my friend forever and His offer of friendship extends to everyone everywhere! They will hear true stories from the Bible about people who chose to follow Jesus and to encourage others to follow Him as well. Meanwhile, our elementary age students will be learning about Peace. Elementary kids will discuss biblical examples of peacemakers and be reminded that Jesus died and rose again in order to make peace between us and God our Father. Peace is almost always costly. Peace means proving you care more about each other than about winning an argument. Our kids will look to Abraham, Abigail, and others in the Bible who chose peace. When we are focused I on peace we will choose to honor the people around us whether we agree with them or not even if it costs us our pride or seems unfair. Jesus died for us not because we deserved it, but because He loved us enough to suffer on our behalf in order to reconcile us to Himself. Last month we learned that kindness is showing people they are valuable by how we treat them and our study of peace will also rely on the core belief that all people are created in God's image and valuable in His sight.


ANNUAL EASTER EGG HUNT


