This is an exciting and historic moment to be part of Faith church. The groundbreaking will be a milestone moment to celebrate what God has done and is continuing to do. We will pray that the new building will be a tool to help us reach new people, serve our community, and be faithful in serving God's purposes.

We will have special worship services in which we will celebrate how far we have come by faith since we launched our first JOURNEY Campaign in March of 2014. Rev. Tom Melzoni will be preaching in all the celebration services and we will have messages of encouragement from representatives of our United Methodist Annual Conference.

The 11:00 am groundbreaking will include representatives from Montoursville, our Susquehanna Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church, Turnkey Construction, and Faith Church.

On Monday, May 8 please join us for a special day of prayer for the United Methodist Church (UMC). Participate in our prayer vigil by signing up online (www.SignUpGenius.com/go/5080F44AFAA2DA1FF2-praying) or at the tables in the Lobby for a specific 15 minute time period to pray between 12:00-4:00 am or 12:00-4:00 pm. Also plan on joining us at 7:00 pm for a joint prayer service with First UMC, Williamsport and First UMC, Muncy hosted at Faith Church (nursery care provided up to age 2). The day of prayer is part of a 24/7, 75 week denominational prayer focus begun January 1, 2017. Each annual conference of the 12 million member UMC has been given a week of prayer. The week for the Susquehanna Annual Conference is May 7 - 13, 2017 and the day for Faith Church and the Williamsport District is May 8. The prayer initiative is a response to the ongoing difficult conversations in the denomination about our differences around issues of human sexuality. In preparation for a special General Conference in 2019 to address the issues and in support of the work of a commission that is currently working on proposals to find a way forward, we are called to a worldwide time of prayer. The prayer focus will be (1) the mission of the United Methodist Church of making disciples for the transformation of the world and (2) the work of The Commission on a Way Forward. 
