Orange Spotlight

I am grateful for the privilege of participating in the presentation of Bibles to our 3rd grade students during worship services on Sept. 30-Oct 1. The annual Bible presentation is a source of joy to many in the church. As we celebrate the students, we reflect on the amazing gift we have been given of living in a time and place where we have access to God's words. The Bible is the living Word of God and we hold it in our hands! Each week I have the unique privilege of watching all of our Kid Connection teachers sharing the Bible with children. Kid Connection leaders are faithfully introducing children to the wonder, might, and love of our God who has created us, redeemed us, and continues to guide us daily.

During October, our preschoolers will discuss several stories from the life of King David and learn that God is always with us even when we experience unexpected challenges. Meanwhile, our elementary classes will be discussing stewardship defined as taking care of what you have because it all belongs to God. Your child will learn that everything they own or use including their time belongs to God and so they should use it wisely and generously to glorify Him.
