PASTOR'S PEN

Sometimes you want to do something, but it's hard to figure out how to get started. If you stop to think about it, I bet you could identify a 'something' like that in your own life. It might be that you can't figure out where to make the time, or who to talk to about it, or if the timing is right. You probably can think of your own set of reasons. In my own life, getting started with something can be the biggest challenge.

This was the case this last year as I tried to figure out how to plug into a Community Group where I could surround myself with other people who would help me grow to be more like Jesus. I knew that I wanted to be part of a group. I knew all the benefits and I could feel that it was a missing piece of my spiritual growth. And yet, I was stuck on the best way to make it work for my schedule. I just couldn't get started.

Finally this summer, I reached out to a few people who I knew weren't in a Community Group and chose a time and got started. I didn't know exactly what we would study together, I didn't know

whether the time we chose would really work, I didn't know a lot. I only knew one thing – I needed to stop putting it off and I needed to get started.

Several weeks later, I am so glad that I did. Sitting with other followers of Jesus who are there to all grow in our faith and help others do the same has helped me to sharpen my focus on my relationship with Jesus and begIn to build deeper faith friendships.

It hasn't been without some sacrifice – it requires me to commit to an early morning that I could have otherwise gone to the gym or slept in. But, nothing worthwhile is achieved without some sacrifice. And having others to help me do the most important thing in my life – follow Jesus – is totally worth it. I'm so glad I got started.

Maybe you are in a similar place to where I was. Community Group life sounds good to you, but you just can't figure out how to get started.

If that is you, I want to challenge you to take advantage of our churchwide study that will begin the last weekend in September. We will be studying 'Unafraid' along with the sermon series as we consider what it looks like to live with courage in the face of our fears. Along with the sermon series, we are providing everything you need to 'get started' (for more information see the article in the Grow section of the newsletter).

Our goal for the 'church wide' is that it will help you get started. Don't wait another month, another year, or another decade. Just get started. I guarantee you will be glad you did!

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

We are almost at the end of the second phase of construction! Here is what has been happening and what is yet to come!

- August: The parking and site work finished. Food Bank Renovations complete. New Staff offices in the Brushy Ridge Road side are finished.
- September: Construction for this phase will finish on the gym. We have been told that we will have occupancy by the end of September. This will mean the temporary wall in the Faith Café will come down and we will begin to use the gym! We also will be focusing on our landscaping around the church now that the construction is complete.

Future: The Church Council and Facilities Design Team have been working through details of when we will be able to do some work to refresh the sanctuary and to do the final stage of construction in the gym so that we can have contemporary worship and our permanent rubber gym floor. Look for more information in the coming months about our timeline for these future phases. Many of us lack confidence in our prayer lives and so we turn to others who seem to have a better grasp on that spiritual discipline. Even though many of us may feel ill-equipped, as United Methodists, prayer has been a big part of our tradition from the inception of the Methodist movement.

John Wesley, one of the forefathers of the United Methodist Church, gave 3 rules that we as United Methodists are expected to engage in:

- Do no harm
- Do good
- Attend upon all the ordinances of God (sometimes referred to as "stay in love with God") In Wesley's list of examples for the 3rd rule, he included: "family and private prayer."

Learning to pray is a bit like learning to ride a bicycle. What we can learn from a book or class is not enough. Confidence and proficiency come through practice.

Here are some things to remember with prayer:

- There is no one-size-fits-all technique. Prayer is a form of communication and so each of us needs to find our unique style.
- Prayer is time well spent no matter what. Even if we feel like we've used all the wrong words, spending 15 minutes, an hour, a day or a season practicing your prayer life is time well spent.
- Experiment with new-to-you ways of prayer. There are many different styles and ways to pray. Take some time to explore some new and different ways. You might be surprised to find what works best for you.


It's Almost Time for Music Groups to Start

KID CONNECTION - ORANGE SPOTLIGHT (THE YELLOW OF CHURCH AND THE RED OF HOME COMBINE TO MAKE ORANGE.) During September, we will be looking at some Old Testament stories and the truths found there about our relationship with God and our neighbors. Our preschoolers learn that God keeps His promises and can be trusted with their problems, hopes, and fears. They will look Exodus and Genesis and learn about Noah, Moses, and Abraham. Meanwhile, our elementary kids are discussing initiative and why having initiative mirrors the character of God. Initiative is seeing what needs to be done and doing it! God took the initiative in relationship with us by sending prophets, kings, and eventually Jesus to continually bring His I wandering people back to Himself. 

Also, the Food Bank in that wing is nearing completion enabling us to begin our Harvest of Hope ministry. Even though the gymnatorium will not be fully completed for worship services for a while (Phase 2), by the end of September we will be able to occupy that space for gatherings and activities which require more room.

At that time we will be re-keying most of the doors in the facility to fully take advantage of our security system. Visitors will still be able to gain access by contacting the office through the outside intercom. For those who need access after business hours, fobs (issued by the office staff) will operate with electronic readers which are currently at the main doors on the Fairview Drive wing and the new Children's Wing exterior doors. Once the changing of locks is complete, current exterior door keys will be obsolete. If you need to open the church for a ministry or serving role please contact the church office (office@faithu.net) for an electronic key fob. As with all new procedures it may take a little getting used to, but once up and running the new system will make access easier, and more importantly give our facilities that extra security.
